Day 1. Miami

Miami - the most beloved and popular resort in America.

Central Street Miami Beach - Collins Avenue. Colorful architectural district Art Deco. The famous South Beach. Business cards of Lincoln Road and Ocean Drive. Villa Versace. Three Mile Bridge Mac Arthur Coaseway. Islands where the most famous and wealthy people of the world live. The modern business center of the city is Downtown Miami. Bank Street Briel Avenue.

Day 3. Naples and Fort Myers

Naples - the pearl of the south-west coast of Florida. This is where you can admire the most fantastic nature of North America. Naples is a unique place where the number of holes for golf and tennis courts far exceeds the number of locals. In addition, as the locals say, the sunset in Naples is the most beautiful

in America.

Moving to Fort Myers

Fort Myers is primarily associated with the residents of Florida with the great inventor of the 19th - 20th centuries. Here is the house and estate of Thomas Edison. Every year, 380,000 people come from all over the United States and from abroad to visit this unique place, which is one of the ten most visited historic homes in America. During the tour we will also visit the workshop of Henry Ford and the botanical garden of 8.5 hectares in size, numbering more than a thousand species of all kinds of plants.

Day 4. Miracle Lake

Miracle Lake is a famous mineral spring in Florida. Indians revered this sacred lake. They called it the "Fountain of Youth" and carefully guarded from all newcomers. The diameter of the lake is up to 175 meters, the depth is up to 79 meters. Mineral content in the lake is higher than in any other lake in America, and worldwide it is ranked third in terms of mineralization.

In the evening transfer to Sarasota

Day 5. Sarasota and Tampa

Sarasota is not only a resort with a wonderful climate and perfect beaches, but also a place where cultural life is in full swing, and there are almost more attractions than in the rest of Florida. In Sarasota, there are 42 properties listed in the National Treasure List of the United States.

Moving to Tampa

This city is one of the most attractive places to live in the United States. The atmosphere here speaks for itself, and the feeling of prosperity is felt at every turn. The local climate, sustainable urban environment, natural resources and economic progress together create a place that locals and others who are proud to visit are proud of.

A visit to the Henry Plant Museum - Florida's railway magnate.

Day 6. St. Petersburg

St. Petersburg in the state of Florida was founded and named by a native of the Russian Empire in honor of the city of the same name in Russia more than 120 years ago. The city is famous for year-round sunshine and pelicans, it is washed by the Gulf of Mexico and Tampa Bay. We will drive into the city through the unique Sunshine Skyway Bridge. This beautiful, long, majestic bridge is one of the longest cable-stayed bridges in the world, overhanging the Tampa Strait. Its length is 6.6 km.

Visit to the Salvador Dali Museum

The collection includes 96 oil paintings, over 100 watercolors and drawings by Salvador Dali, 1300 graphic works, photographs, sculptures and art objects. In addition, 7 of 18 monumental paintings by Dali are kept in the museum (the size of the side is more than one and a half meters, the work is more than a year). The Salvador Dali Museum in St. Petersburg is the largest city after the Theater Museum in Figueres, in Spain.

Devil's Lair - Florida's most ancient cave

Devil's Den Cave - Prehistoric Spring - one of the oldest prehistoric sites in North America, in a cave artifacts, human remains aged 7500 years BC have been found, and fossils of animals of the Pleistocene / Pleistocene era or Drevnechetvertichnogo period, including the mastodon remains, sloths, lemmmings, spectacled bears and saber-toothed tigers.
